



OSAT – PEG Insertion

<p>Puncture Site Identification and Preparation</p>	<p>Confirms stomach location endoscopically; locates appropriate puncture site at point of maximum transillumination; utilizes sterile technique to prepare site</p>	<p>Requires some prompting</p>	<p>Unable to identify puncture site; breach in sterile technique</p>	
<p>Tube Placement</p>	<p>Makes adequately sized incision; properly inserts puncture needle/trochar /pull wire; advances tube over pull wire with ease and checks internal retention disc endoscopically; makes efficient use of snare</p>	<p>Experienced some difficulty in inserting instrument, but watched monitor</p>	<p>Great difficulty in inserting instruments and tube and does not watch monitor</p>	
<p>Securing Tube</p>	<p>Secures tube with external fixation disc and keeps it tension free; correctly applies clamps and feeding connector</p>	<p>Requires some prompting</p>	<p>Does not apply external fixation disc; applies excessive tension</p>	
<p>Placement Confirmation</p>	<p>Confirms placement endoscopically</p>		<p>Does not confirm placement</p>	
<p>Documentation</p>	<p>Documents introduced length and tube size</p>		<p>Does not document introduced length or tube size</p>
