Puncture Site Identification and Preparation	Confirms stomach location endoscopically; locates appropriate puncture site at point of maximum transillumination; utilizes sterile technique to prepare site	Requires some prompting	Unable to identify puncture site; breach in sterile technique	
Tube Placement	Makes adequately sized incision; properly inserts puncture needle/trochar /pull wire; advances tube over pull wire with ease and checks internal retention disc endoscopically; makes efficient use of snare	Experienced some difficulty in inserting instrument, but watched monitor	Great difficulty in inserting instruments and tube and does not watch monitor	
Securing Tube	Secures tube with external fixation disc and keeps it tension free; correctly applies clamps and feeding connector	Requires some prompting	Does not apply external fixation disc; applies excessive tension	
Placement Confirmation	Confirms placement endoscopically		Does not confirm placement
